- Grade 12 Recommended (min requirements are Grade 11 Math and Grade 11 Science)
- A Criminal Record and Vulnerable Sector Check may be required by your work placement
- Valid Class 5 Driver's License required
- Compliance to RTSC's fit for duty policy
- English Language Requirement (CLB Level 6 required for Apprenticeship)
