## REQUIREMENTS

- Must be a CANADIAN CITIZEN, A PERMANENT RESIDENT or have an OPEN WORK PERMIT TO APPLY
- Grade 12 Recommended (min requirements are Grade 11 Math and Grade 10 Science)
- Valid Class 5 Driver's License Required
- Clean drivers abstract and SDR will be required at interview)
- Criminal Record Check may be required by Work Placement
- English Language Requirement
- Compliance to RTSC's fit for duty policy
