## ELECTRICAL – 10 WEEK COURSE

Regina Trades & Skills Centre is offering an entry-level training course for those interested in starting a career as an Electrician. This program has no tuition costs, and includes a two-week industry work placement at the end of the course to help you connect with employers. Many of our partnering employers are actively looking to hire, making this a great opportunity to begin a high-demand trade.

Throughout the course, you will learn about hand and power tools, materials, and equipment, along with the essential skills needed to secure entry-level employment in the electrical industry.

## REQUIREMENTS

- MUST BE A CANADIAN CITIZEN OR A PERMANENT RESIDENT TO APPLY - SATCC requirements for apprenticeship
- Grade 12 Recommended (min requirements are Grade 11 Math and Grade 10 Science)
- Valid Class 5 Driver's License Required  
(Clean drivers abstract and SDR will be required at interview)
- Criminal Record Check may be required by Work Placement
- English Language Requirement
- Compliance to RTSC's fit for duty policy
