POWERLINE TECHNICIAN – 8 WEEK COURSE

Regina Trades & Skills Centre offers an entry level Powerline Technician course. The program will provide students with the basic fundamental knowledge and practical skills needed to gain employment in the Powerline industry. This industry and training requires a high level of physical fitness for the trade, including working at heights, comfort and agility. You will learn about hand and power tools, materials, equipment, pole climbing, rigging and more. You will learn all skills needed to secure entry level employment in this industry.

REQUIREMENTS

- MUST BE A CANADIAN CITIZEN OR PERMANENT RESIDENT TO APPLY - SATCC requirements for apprenticeship
- Compliance to RTSC's fit for duty policy (MUST PASS A PRE-ACCESS DRUG & ALCOHOL TEST)
- Grade 12 Recommended (Apprenticeship requirements are Grade 11 Math and Grade 11 Science)
- A Criminal Record and Vulnerable Sector Check may be required by your work placement
- Valid Class 5 Driver's License required
- English Language Requirement
